

Cities OK New Terms For Dequindre Sewer

Construction of the Dequindre interceptor sewer is near reality today.

Birmingham city commissioners and other area municipal officials in the past week have adopted a resolution making it possible to begin construction by Jan. 1.

That deadline was necessary in order for the participating com-

munities to receive a Federal grant of \$1.3 million.

The new provision stipulates that Oakland County will not dispose of additional sewage facilities made possible through a new agreement with Detroit unless it gets the consent of 75 per cent of the 14 municipalities now paying for the interceptor.

IT ALSO assures that these communities will be able to purchase additional capacity whenever they find it necessary.

It stipulates further that proceeds from the sale of any of the additional flowage will be distributed proportionately to these same communities.

The resolution was drawn up by Claude H. Stevens, county bonding consultant.

It ended a controversy of two weeks, in which some local and area officials wondered who had made an administrative error.
