Detroit Girl, 16, Dies Following Two-Car Crash

BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP — A 16-year-old Detroit girl died last week of injuries suffered in a crash Nov. 18 at Telegraph and Quanton Roads.

Patricia Verikas died two days later at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Pontiac. She suffered a broken neck, broken jaws, and brain and chest injuries in the accident.

Patricia was thrown from a car in which she was a passenger. It was driven by Michael A. O'Rourke, 19, of Detroit.

Police said O'Rourke attempted to cross Telegraph from eastbound Quanton Road. His car collided with one driven by Thomas L. McNaughton, 23, of Clarkston. McNaughton was driving south on Telegraph.

Oakland County Prosecutor George Taylor said Friday that statements had been taken from both drivers and that no evidence of negligence was indicated.

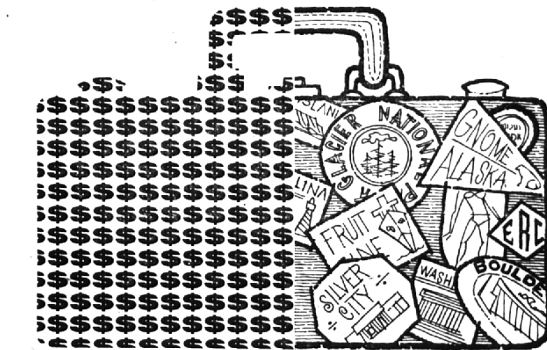

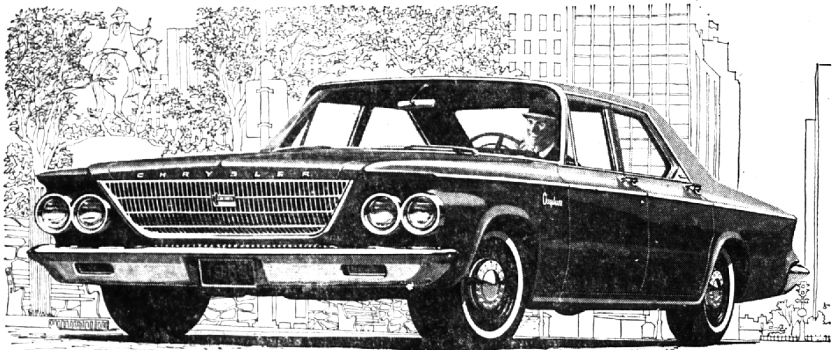
