PRESENTATION OF the "Knight" awards will be made by trustees of Maryglade College, Memphis, Mich., which will benefit from proceeds of the dinner.

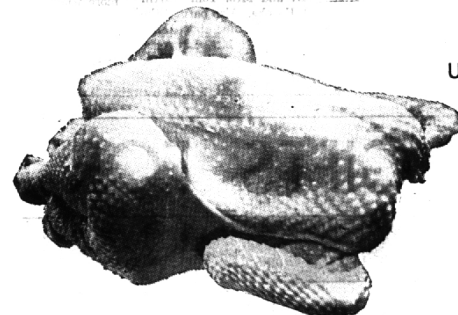
