Pi Beta Phi Members to View Founding Place

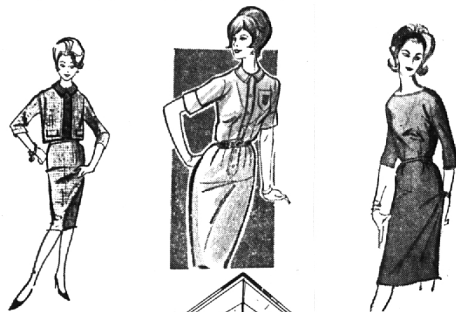

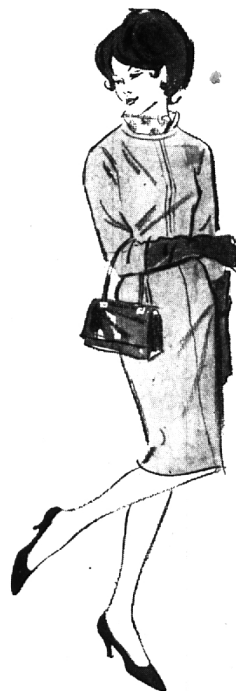
