Drive for St. Joe's Enlists Localites

St. Joseph Mercy Hospital Auxiliary, founded in the depression years of 1929 to assist the Sisters of the hospital in their work, has been a medium of continuing service ever since.

Originally, operational funds were obtained through annual tag days.

However, so many tag days originated that the Auxiliary was forced to abandon this type of fund raising and initiated biennial Denim Dances. They were rewarding popular with Birmingham-Bloomfield people, serving to raise money the festive way.

SINCE ITS origin, the Auxiliary has purchased over \$100,000 worth of equipment for the hospital, in addition to supporting the Out-Patient Clinic by providing \$250 per month to purchase X-rays, laboratory tests and glasses ordered for indigent patients.

With the rapid growth of the area, St. Joseph has become a vital part of community life, and

the Auxiliary has grown along with it. Recently it has established a Gift and Mobile Cart to service both the hospital patients and their friends.

Currently the Auxiliary is in the throes of a membership drive, added impetus for new faces coming with the re-activating of the School of Nursing, which got underway early this fall and where help is already needed.
