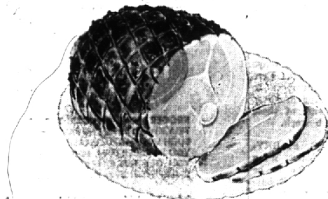

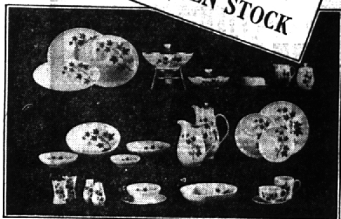
Members will gather at 8:30 for a happy hour preceding the dancing to renew acquaintances and welcome new members.
