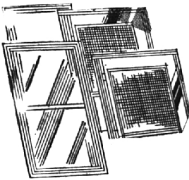

VILLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 29 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE HEIGHT, NUMBER OF STORIES AND SIZE OF BUILDINGS; THE SIZE OF OPEN SPACES; THE DENSITY OF POPULATION; THE LOCATION AND USE OF BUILDINGS AND LAND FOR TRADE, RESIDENCE AND OTHER PURPOSES; CREATING DISTRICTS FOR SAID PURPOSES AND ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR CHANGES IN REGULATIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND BOUNDARIES OF SUCH DISTRICTS; DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS USED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; ESTABLISHMENT OF A ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS; AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE."

The Village of Beverly Hills Ordains:
 Section 1.01. That Ordinance No. 29 entitled "An Ordinance Regulating and Restricting the Height, Number of Stories and Size of Buildings; the Size of Open Spaces; the Density of Population; the Location and Use of Buildings and Land for Trade, Residence and Other Purposes; Creating Districts for said purposes and Establishing the Boundaries Thereof; Providing for Changes in Regulations and Boundaries of Such Districts; Defining Certain Terms Used Herein; Providing for Enforcement; Establishment of a Zoning Board of Appeals; and Imposing Penalties for the Violation of this Ordinance" be and the same hereby is amended by amending the Zone Map attached thereto and made a part thereof as follows:

A. That the following described property is changed from a single residential two (R-2) zone use to residential two-a (R-2A) zone use:

Part of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 2, T. 1 N., R. 10 E., Village of Beverly Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point which is S. 88° 29' W. along the South line of Section 2 a distance of 635.00 ft. from the Southeast corner of Section 2, T. 1 N., R. 10 E., thence along said South line of Section 2 S. 88° 29' W. 493.00 ft.; thence S. 01° 32' 17" W. 433.12 ft.; thence Northeastly approximately 160 ft.; thence Southeastly approximately 160 ft. along a curve concave to the Northeast; thence Northwesterly approximately 100 ft. along a curve concave to the Northwest; thence Northwesterly approximately 62 ft.; thence N. 01° 32' 17" W. approximately 305 ft.; thence along the centerline of the Evans Drain Northwesterly approximately 430 ft.; thence N. 01° 32' 17" W. approximately 25 ft.; thence S. 89° 53' E. 349.59 ft.; thence S. 01° 18' 30" E. 962.21 ft.; thence S. 88° 29' W. 301.00 ft.; thence S. 01° 18' 30" E. 333.00 ft. to the point of beginning.

Section 2.01. Public hearing having been held hereon on October 1, 1962, and the statutory notices having been published and mailed, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be immediately necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety and are hereby ordered to take effect immediately upon publication.
