

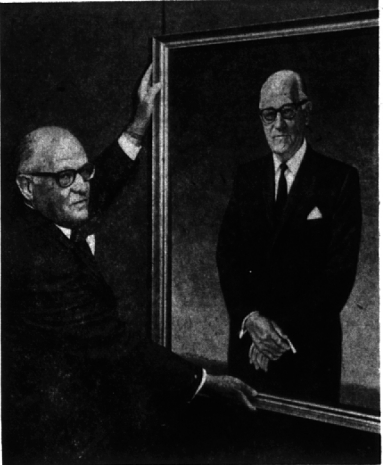
A Doctor's Image

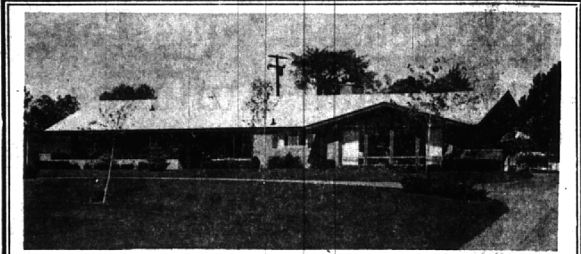


Kirk-in-the-Hills' Vesper Services Feature Organist

Featured soloist at Kirk-in-the-Hills' first vesper service this fall on Oct. 28 will be Dr. Marilyn Mason, head of the organ department at the University of Michigan and the only woman who has ever played at Westminster Abbey. The performance will mark the beginning of the third annual series of non-denominational vesper services.

OTHER SCHEDULED events are Handel's "Messiah" on Dec. 2 and Bach's "Mass in B Minor" on Feb. 17 and 24, performed by the Kirk choir, soloists, orchestra and organ, with Phillip Steinhaus (the Kirk's organist-choirmaster-carillonist) conducting. On March 31, Alice Stentz, contralto, will be accompanied by Steinhaus in a recital of "Sacred Music of Solo Voice and Organ."

A NEW SHOW opens Sunday at the Little Gallery featuring the jeweled creations of three great artists-craftsmen.

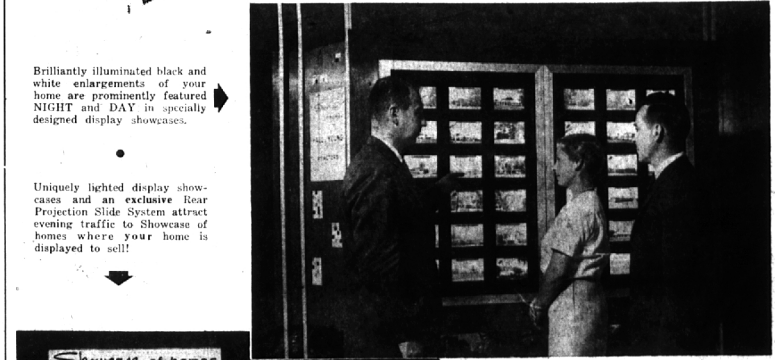
