Blue Jays Drop 25-7 Decision To Waterford

Borrowing the theme of a popular song, Southfield just couldn't "get started" until too late Friday night and dropped a 25-7 decision to Waterford.

The Blue Jays failed to make a first down in the first two periods and watched almost helplessly as Waterford rolled up 190 yards and scored three touchdowns.

HOWEVER, Southfield managed to mount an offensive in the third and fourth quarters, picking up 10 first downs and scoring seven points.

The Blue Jay tally came on a two-yard run through the middle by Bucky Straw with two minutes left in the game.

Tom Grile scored two touchdowns for the winners, on runs of two and 11 yards. Clark Lemaux, on a dash of one yard and Grant, on a 16-yard run, accounted for the other touchdowns.

Among other things, four pass interceptions hurt Southfield in the first half. Waterford picked up a total of 273 yards as compared to 199 for the Blue Jays.

120,000 Acres in State Open For Hunting

Small game hunters should find about 120,000 acres of private lands open to public shooting this season in southern Michigan under a cooperative game management program carried out by farmer clubs and the Conservation Department.

The program, popularly known as the Williamson Plan, is designed to yield an orderly hunt game and to minimize hunter trespass problems.

AN ESTIMATED 2,000 farmers will make their lands available to hunters this fall. Signs will be posted to designate land units enrolled in the program.

Hunters are reminded they must obtain all guest permits or tickets from owners before going afield on these lands. When cooperating farmers have given out all their permits, no more hunters will be allowed on their property until some of the permits are returned.

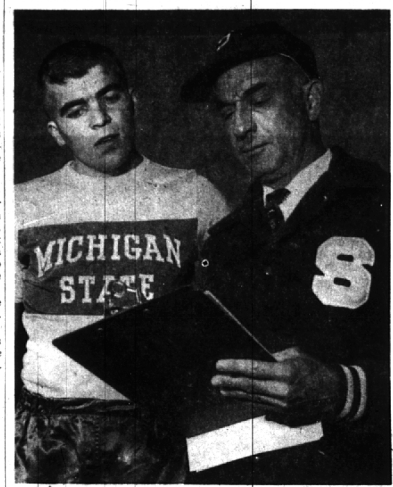
HUNTER QUOTAS are determined by Williamson Plan clubs and permits are distributed to each member accordingly.

The permit system benefits both hunters and farmers. It allows for a systematic harvest of the annual game crop, much of which might otherwise be wasted. At the same time, it controls hunter numbers to help protect farmer interests.

As in the past, the success of this year's cooperative hunting program depends upon the actions of hunters. Those who gain access to private lands are urged to follow the rules of hunting safety to the hilt.

Hunters should learn areas that are off limits to shooting and stay clear of them to prevent damage to livestock, crops, and buildings. At all times, they should respect their privilege of hunting on private lands by using common sense and courtesy.

Most hunting victims are shot by themselves or nearby companions. Pick your hunting buddies carefully. Hunt with the safety on, or keep your gun unloaded. Keep gun muzzles pointed away from other hunters and you All Of The Time. Keep loaded guns out of cars.
