Home Building On Increase In W. B'field
 WEST BLOOMFIELD—A building report made to West Bloomfield Township board members at their meeting last week disclosed a vast increase in home building in the township.
 New construction during September was valued at \$445,525, of which homes accounted for \$411,500. During the same period last year new construction amounted to \$138,300, with \$90,000 going toward homes.
 Fire department reports for September showed a \$145 loss, with property endangered valued at \$58,000. The department made five house runs in the township, one in Sylvan City and one in Keego Harbor.
 Township police issued 13 traffic violations during the month and handled 111 complaints.

C., last Monday, when several hundred business leaders from all parts of the United States reviewed their roles in event of a national emergency.
