Group Tells Need For Development Of Private Parks

BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP — Increasing camping and park facilities in Oakland County was discussed at a meeting of the State Legislative Committee on State Parks and Lands Tuesday night at Bloomfield Township Hall.

The committee, headed by Reimer Van Til of Holland, seeks to develop more public recreational facilities for the increasing Michigan population.

The committee stressed that the state will not be able to provide for all the park needs, and that private land developers must provide neighborhood recreational parks in conjunction with home-land development.

Work Progresses On Rezoning In Lathrup Village

LATHRUP — Work is progressing on new ordinances which will change the zoning of Southfield Road and 12 Mile Road. When the legal descriptions are ready, the council will continue work with the City Development Committee to rezone the now-residential areas to various commercial and professional uses.

Other changes are proposed for council meeting procedures. The council will meet to study a report compiled by Mayor Richard N. Cogger incorporating suggestions from the International Council of City Managers.

"I'D LIKE to see what we could do to avoid the necessity of long meetings," Cogger said.

A need for some charter revision was also discussed. Since the

Commissioners have tackled various portions of the codification in the past several months, but have been reluctant to delve into the entire project because of the time element.

The codification consists of remodeling some old laws, writing some new ones and discarding obsolete ones. Actually, it is a means of simplifying the city's ordinances by organizing, updating and unifying them.
