

### Study Nursing Home Zoning For B'ham

The Birmingham Plan Board has been asked to study possible zoning provisions to allow for nursing and convalescence homes in the city. City commissioners referred the

matter to the plan board at Tuesday night's commission meeting. CITY PLANNER William R. Brownfield said the zoning ordinance does not specify in what zones districts these uses may locate. The plan board is to study the matter to determine appropriate locations and controls to regulate the uses and to make recommendations to the commission.

### 'Uninvited Guest' Denies Remark on Communism

George Romney's campaign for governor swung into high gear last weekend amid a controversy over his alleged statement about communists within the Democratic party and a much-publicized "uninvited" appearance at a Labor Rally at the fairgrounds. Romney walked in front of the band, behind which Swainson rode in a convertible in a parade prior to the rally. Romney walked along the curb shaking hands. Romney had been denied permission to speak from the platform at the rally prior to the event on the basis that the program had been set up before Romney asked to be included in it.

party centered around remarks Romney made at a press conference Aug. 25, on the eve of the Republican state convention. State Democratic Chairman John J. Collins sent a complaint to the National Fair Campaign Practices Committee, on the grounds that the national party had been implicated. In a discussion of the problem of extremists within parties, he had been quoted as saying: "THE EXTREMISTS who try to infiltrate the Democratic Party are the Communists. In the last 30 to 35 years they have worked them-

selves into positions of importance not only in government but into the ranks of the party." Romney was questioned by the NFPCC as to whether he had been accurately quoted. He replied that he did not believe that the Democratic Party would knowingly harbor a Communist inside the party. The Republican gubernatorial candidate visited three factories and a shopping center in Flint Tuesday. YESTERDAY he visited the Dodge Main plant and shopping centers in Hamtramck. Today he will be involved in staff conferences and tomorrow will campaign in Clinton and Lenawee Counties. An appearance at the Oakland County Republican ox roast and picnic at the John F. Ivory farm near Union Lake is slated for Saturday.
