Public Bank's Trailer Move Gets Approval

BEVERLY HILLS—The Public Bank's trailer will move soon to a new location next to the Wrigley Supermarket at 13 Mile road and Southfield. Tentative approval was given by the council at Tuesday's meeting.

Bruce R. Benway, executive vice president of the bank, requested the change. The bank's permanent location will also be changed to the same area, closer to the shopping center to be erected near the store.

Approval was given by the council, subject to execution of an agreement between the village of Beverly Hills and Allied Supermarkets, Inc., in which the Allied Supermarkets will agree to bear the cost of water and sewer lines to service the area.

THE VILLAGE manager was given power to grant the permit to the bank when the agreement is reached. The new location will be in the Wrigley parking lot, immediately north of the most northerly entrance to the Wrigley property on Southfield road.
