INCORPORATED as a city in late 1953 from a part of Southfield Township, its affairs are legislated by a five-member council.

Council members, who are not paid for their services, rely on the city administrator to steer the daily operation of the municipality.

Lathrup's council is elected on a rotation basis to insure experienced I e a d e r s. Each 'April, three are elected—two for two-year terms and one for a one-fear term. Following the elec-tion, the five meet and name a mayor pro tem from a mong themselves.

THE NEW COUNCIL also designates the dates for meetings, in April, for the ensuing year. Currently, it me et a the second and fourth Monday of each month in the AAA building at 26026 Southfield Road.

The municipal offices have been housed since May in part of a former supermarket at. 28911 Southfield, for which \$200 rent is paid per month.

Before this, the city offices were headquartered in a former mansion, owned by Mr. and Mrs.

FROM ITS Southfield Road offices, the business of the city is managed from day-to-day by the administrator and his staff.
