Section 6.01. PROSECUTION UPON BONDS. 

ORDINANCE NO. 57 AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE CONSTRUCTION, RECON-STRUCTION, REPAIR AND CLEANING OF SIDEWALKS IN THE VULLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS.

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to grant a permit to any property owner to construct, reconstruct or repair a sidewalk in front of or adjacent to any property owned by him, conditioned that such owner is skilled and competent to construct the same in accordance with the provisions hereof.

Section 8.01. REVOCATION OF PERMITS OR LICENSES.

The Village Manager may cause work to be stopped under any permit or license transet for the construction, reconstruction or repair of side-walks for Incompetency or failure to comply with the terms of this ordinance or the engineering specifications of the Village, until the next regular meeting of the Village Council. At the next regular meeting of the Village Council. Section 9.01. EMERGENCY REPAIRS.

Whenever for any reason any sidewalk shall become out of repair and in such condition as to be a menace to the safety of the public, the Village Manager shall be authorized to make immediate repairs to the village Manager shall be authorized to make immediate repairs to the value of cocupant of the premises in front of or adjacent to which such side walk is located. Section 11.01. DUTY TO KEEP SIDEWALKS FREE FROM ICE SNOW AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS.

The owners of property abutting or adjacent to sidewalks shall keep said sidewalk abutting or adjacent to their property free and clear of do so, the Village may do so and assess the cost thereof against the abutting property or owner thereof in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance and the Village Charter. Section 12.01. DEFINITIONS.

Section 301. PERMIT.

No sidewalk shall hereafter be constructed or repaired in the Village of Beverly Hills without a permit being obtained therefor from the Village Clerk. Under the terms of such permit the owner will agree to engineering specifications of the Village and the grade established in such specifications as well as the terms of this ordinance. No permit shall lisute except upon payment of a fee to the Treasurer in the amount of \$1.00 for each 100 square feet of sidewalk or fraction thereof with and cost of inspection. No permit shall be required for repair of sidewalks involving less than 50 square feet in area. Such permit and permit fee shall not be required for sidewalks constructed or repaired under contract by the Village of Village forces. The term sidewalks as used herein shall be deemed to mean and in-clude any sidewalks or crosswalks adjoining any public street or alley and abutting or adjoining any private property.

Section 13.01 NEW PLATS.

The initial construction of sidewalks in any new plats or subdivision shall be in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.06 of Ordinano No. 28, as amended.

Section 14.01. PENALTIES.

Any person, firm or corporation convicted of violating any of the person of the person

Section 15.01. SHORT TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Village everly Hills Sidewalk Ordinance".

Section 16.01. NUISANCE PER SE.

The provisions of this ordinance shall be also enforceable through the bringing of appropriate action for injunction, mandamus, or otherwise in any court having jurisdiction. The violation of this ordinance shall be deemed a nuisance per se.

Section 17.01. SEVERABILITY.

Section 5-01. SIDEWALK BUILDERS BOILD.

All sidewalk builder's bonds, as provided for by the terms of this quitance, shall be in the penal sum of \$1,000.00 with a recognized surely company, or a personal bond with two or more surelies residing within the County of Gakland, the surrelies to be approved by the Village Manager.
