#### VILLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 28 ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE STATING FORTH THE REQUIREMENTS
FOR NEW SURDIVISION: THE PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED: SETTING FORTH DESIGNS AND STANDARDS:
PROVIDING FOR SPECIFICATIONS: AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF:"

#### THE VILLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS ORDAINS:

Section 1.01. That Ordinance No. 28 entitled "An Ordinance Stating Forth the Requirements for New Subdivision: The Procedures to be Followed: Setting forth Designs and Standards: Providing for Specifications: and Providing Penalties for the Violation Thereof" be and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a new sub-section, Section 6.08 A reading as follows:

thereto of a new sub-section, Section 6.06 A reading as follows: Section 6.06 A. Sideralla, Sidersafts shall be required to be constructed as a condition of approval of the plat in all new plats or subdivisions that bound on a major streef or county primary road of that portion of said plat or subdivision bounding on said major streef or county primary road artifect of colony primary road unless the Village Council, prior street of sport of the plat, shall determine that the public health, safety and Welfare does not require said sidewalk, in which event the Council may waive such requirement. All sidewalks shall be installed, inspected and approved in accordance with the then current engineering specifications of the Village. A cash bond shall be filled with the Village prior to final approval of the plat to guarantee said, improvement being made.

Settibn 2.01. This Ordinarice is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, immediately necessary for the preservation of public place, health and safety, and shall become effective immediately upon publication.


