## Oakland to Build Three Rooms for Special Education

The Oakland County Board of Education voted Thursday to underwrite the construction of three special education rooms in the Farmington School District at a cost of \$55,128.  
All three rooms, two at Highmeadow Elementary School, and one at East Junior High School, will be used for children in the Adjusted Study Program. Dr. Paul Thams, County Director of Special Education, defines these children as those poorly adjusted to function in regular classrooms.  
Similar programs are being operated in Pontiac, Bloomfield Hills, Birmingham, Hazel Park and Walled Lake.  
Farmington School District will conduct and maintain special education programs in these rooms for a period of 15 years. Furnishings, cost of operation and teachers' salaries will be paid by the county under state special education provisions. The contract stipulates that Farmington will accept non-resident special education pupils as assigned by the County Board of Education, without tuition charge.  
The two rooms and half the abutting corridor at Highmeadow School, now under construction at 30175 Highmeadow, cost \$33,789. The room and half the abutting corridor at East Junior High School, now being built at 25000 Middlebelt, cost \$19,343.

## Kubala Gets Jail Sentence In Robbery

A prison sentence of 7 1/2 to 20 years was handed down in the trial of Thomas Kubala, 26, of Lincoln Park, who pleaded guilty three weeks ago to his part in the holdup of J. J. Levy, owner of the Oakland County Gas and Oil Co., Royal Oak.  
Beverly Hills police played a part in the capture of one of the men involved in the holdup. Another man was found dead in the car which the captured man was driving.

Another of the four men accused of the September abduction and holdup of Levy, James Wilson, 27, also of Lincoln Park, will be sentenced Jan. 15. Wilson also pleaded guilty to a charge of armed robbery.

TWO OTHER MEN, Joseph Loncar, 35, of Chatham Park, and Joseph J. Welch, 38, of Hazel Park, are awaiting a new trial.

Attorneys for the latter two men reminded Circuit Judge Frederick C. Ziem that he had received campaign contributions from Levy three years ago.

Ziem declared a mistrial and has asked the state supreme court for an out-county judge to hear the new trial of the pair.

A 6 1/2th bandit, Joseph Rosetti, 35, of Philadelphia, was killed by police in a midnight chase that followed the holdup. Levy was abducted from his home last Sept. 5 and was forced to accompany the robbery to his company headquarters where they tried to loot his office safe.

LEVY WOUNDED two of the five robbers, including Kubala, with a shotgun.

In the police chase that followed, the bandits were pursued by Beverly Hills police who apprehended Loncar. The fifth bandit was found dead in a car which he had rented when the Beverly police forced it to a halt.
