The new camp is located in a stand of hardwood and birch, some six miles east of new Interstate Highway 1-96, at Indian River, Mich.

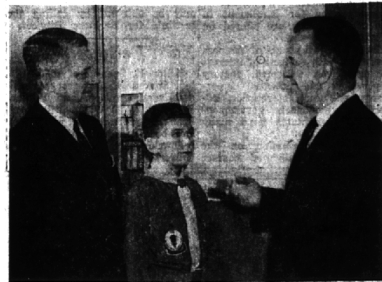

"The Atomic Energy Commission this week made a grant of \$13,000 to MSU Oakland to enable it to begin laboratory instruction in nuclear physics and chemistry.

The money will provide laboratory equipment which will be used by engineering students as well as chemistry and physics majors. This equipment will make it possible to detect radioactive materials in laboratory work.

The use of such radioactive materials as tracers in medicine is common, and their spreading in industry makes it essential, university officials said, that instruction in the measuring and detection of radioactivity be a part of students' scientific preparation.
