The Hon. Nathan J. Kaufman was guest speaker at the October meeting of the Engineering Society of Detroit Junior Wives Wednesday in Detroit.

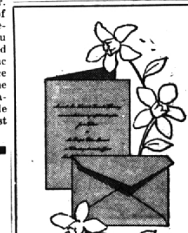
Judge Kaufman, a veteran of 31 years in the practice of law and noted for his work with juveniles, discussed schools, community and the family.

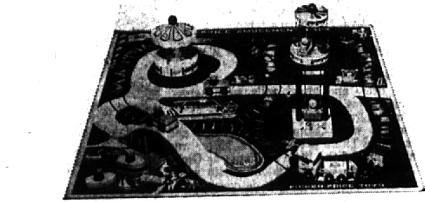
