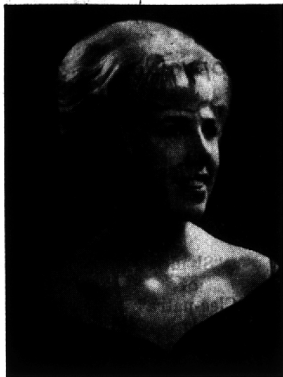


# Add Names to Bridal Roster

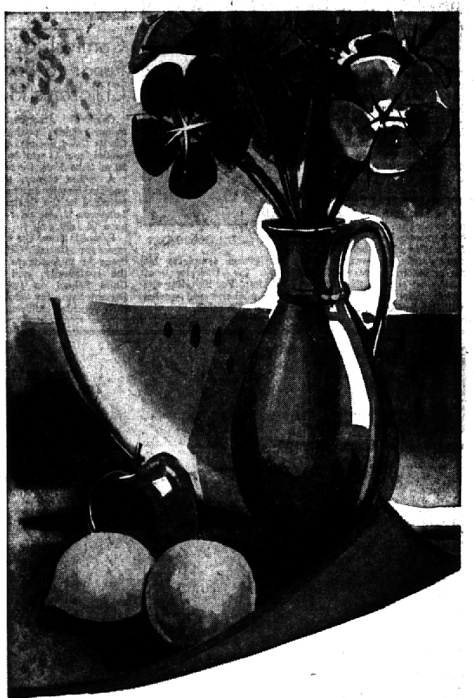
