Obviously, many of these skills require training and there is helpful information on where to secure this training.

WHILE THE BOOK is primarily intended for those who desire to become part of the brigade of women who work on a temporary basis, college students who need extra money to finance their education are considered in an enlightening chapter which gives concrete advice where college students can secure gainful employment which suits their talents and fits in with their future plans.

At the other end of the age bracket from the college students are our older citizens. A very helpful list of jobs available to them and information as to how best to obtain them is the subject of another chapter.

ANOTHER GROUP which often seeks part-time employment are 'moonlighters,' those who have one job but who seek additional employment to augment their income. Their problems and possibilities are examined in depth.

There are helpful hints on how best to apply for jobs and where and what will be expected of you as a part-time worker.

There is an appendix which lists, according to skills, the fields which employ part-time workers, the required qualifications and how the applicant can secure information

Traffic Up At Institute Of Science

The Cranbrook Institute of Science has released its annual report which shows that over 154,000 persons visited the building in the past year—an increase of approximately 15,000 over the previous year. The report covers the period from July 1, 1962, to June 30, 1963. Of those persons passing through its door, about half (70,083 to be exact) were school children. These children came from 125 communities—14 of the communities out-of-state.

The science museum presented 43 new exhibits during the year, along with 11 lecture and film programs, classes for young children and classes for adults.

Among the activities were the annual "bird walks" with staff member Walter P. Nickell, scheduled demonstrations in the Institute's planetarium and its observatory and field trips for junior members.

Many of these pieces are eminently suitable for incorporation as a permanent part of a building, and in fact Mr. Michaels has filled numerous commissions of this type. The smallest of these free standing transparencies could sit on any table.

A WORD OF WARNING here to anyone who might be tempted to try his hand at this type of assembling, using epoxy glue.

Because this kind of work invites imitation, Mr. Michaels feels a personal responsibility to warn people that epoxy glue, when wet, is a highly toxic material, which attacks through the lungs, the eyes or the skin. He uses a protective skin cream and an oxygen mask for long exposure, and warns that small children should be kept strictly away from it, until a piece is dry.

ALSO INCLUDED in this show, and not secondary, except in size and number are small pencil and ink sketches, unmistakably from the same hand as the larger three-dimensional pieces; several small, beautifully executed oil paintings on wood; two collages; four large oil paintings; and a group of east bronzes produced by the lost wax method.

If you really want to take in this show, plan at least two trips. It will hang through Nov. 16.

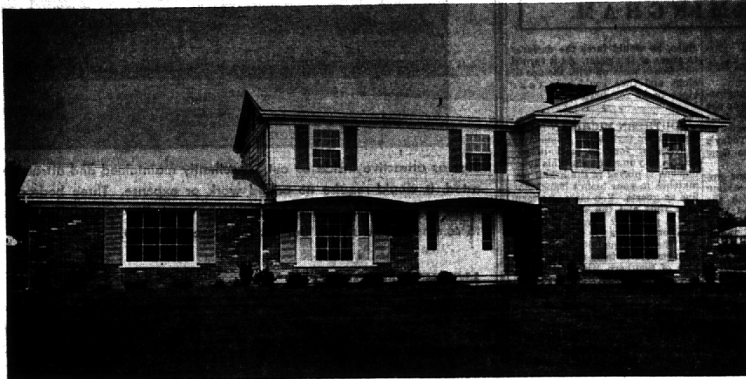

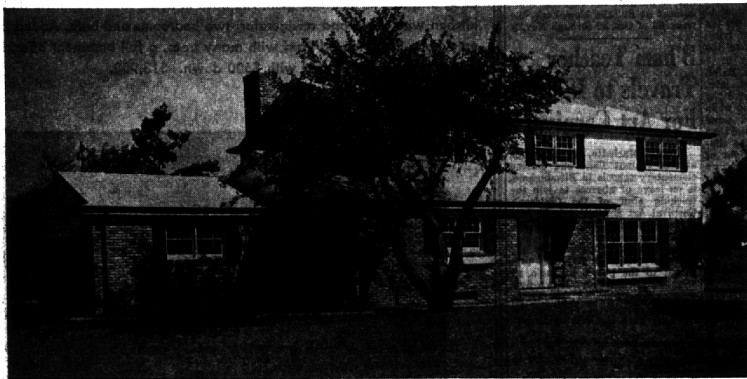

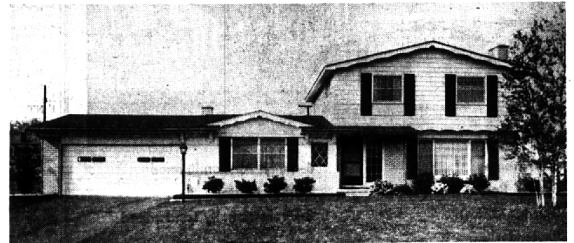
