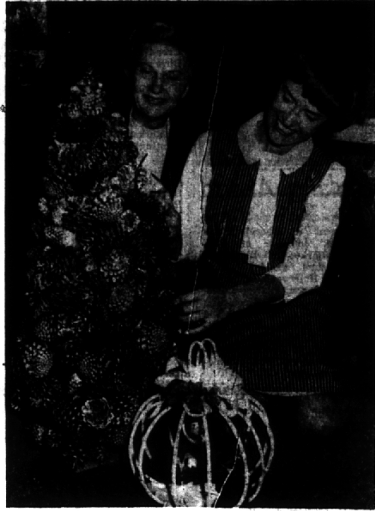

Have You Met...

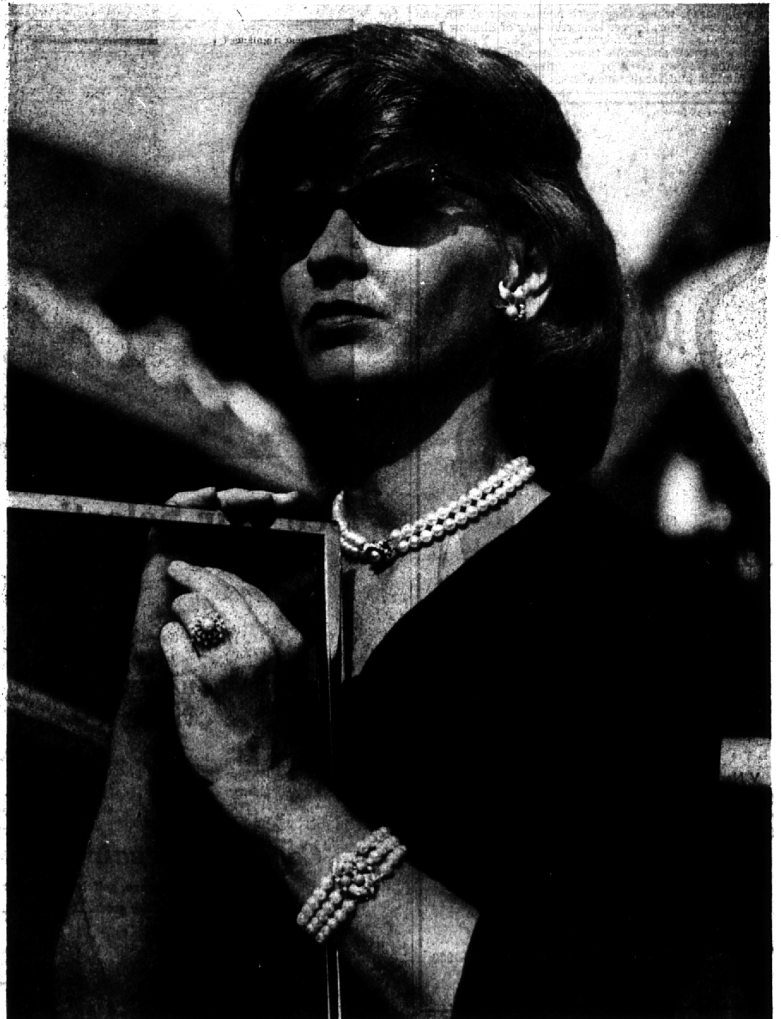
