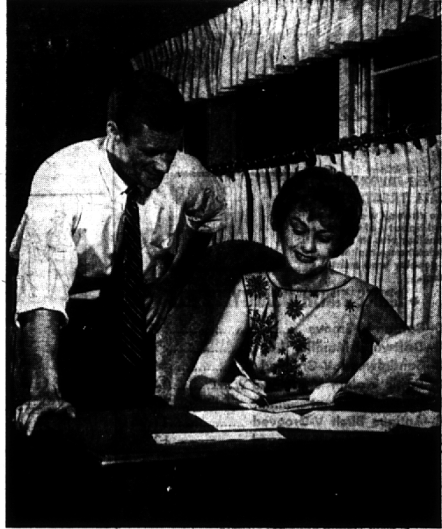
Malcuzyński has toured every continent and will make a sold-out tour of all principal cities in the
