## Roepers Go To Europe on Field Tour

George A. Roeper, headmaster of the City and Country School of Bloomfield Hills, and his wife Annemarie Roeper, director of the nursery and kindergarten of the same school, are among 92 American educators and school board members who will leave New York Nov. 10 for a 21-day educational reform in the Scandinavian countries and Soviet Russia.

It is one of the largest educational groups to visit the USSR in recent years. The trip is sponsored by Phi Delta Kappa, the professional fraternity in education; the Comparative Education Society; and the National School Boards Association.

In charge of the group is Dr. Gerald Read of Kent State University who has led five similar studies in the USSR and numerous trips to Europe, Africa and South America. Assisting Dr. Read is Dr. Donald W. Robinson, associate editor of Phi Delta Kappa publications.
