## Meter Money On Increase, Says Moxley

Parking meter revenue continues to rise in Birmingham, according to Police Chief Ralph W. Moxley. Moxley's quarterly report on the parking situation in Birmingham was presented to city commissioners. Tuesday night.

The average per meter has now reached \$1.85 per meter per week, Moxley said. This compares with a \$1.72 per meter in 1962 and \$1.59 in 1961.


