**ARTerie Gallery Offers Oils from Around World**

A new concept in the merchandising of original oil paintings and other art objects was introduced to the metropolitan Detroit area Friday when The ARTerie, new art gallery housed in a redesigned former used car sales office, opened its doors at Woodward and 13 Mile Road, Royal Oak.

Conceived by former advertising executive Rudy Simons, The ARTerie offers original oil paintings and other art objects from around the world in a price range "from four dollars to four figures." The majority of paintings are priced at less than \$100.

ACTING AS advisors and consultants of The ARTerie in the selection and purchase of paintings are Anthony Adamo, owner of the

Adamo Galleria d'Arte, Fifth Avenue, New York, and Allen Abramson, an Ohioan who has traveled the metropolitan Detroit area during the last 15 years buying a wide variety of art objects and furniture.

"Some of the artists represented at The ARTerie," said Adamo, "have already won wide acclaim for their work. Many others will surely gain recognition in the near future. And some, of course, will not pass the test of time."

"In the meantime, they have one thing in common. All are willing to sell their paintings at reasonable prices for the quality of work they do."

"And this, in turn, makes it possible to offer the public a wide assortment of handsomely-framed

paintings at extremely low prices." ABRAMSON pointed out that there are paintings and other art objects from many European countries as well as Japan, China, Indonesia, Thailand and even Australia. "Well over 1,000 works in all!" Abramson said, "though many of them will not be displayed until later in December."

Among American artists being shown are Detroiters Sue Kohl and Sheldon Lifter.

"It is our desire," said Simons, "to make every person in the metropolitan area a potential art buyer by offering during the coming year a huge selection of paintings and other art objects in every style, subject, size, color, medium, and, of course, price."

THE ARTERIE also offers a "rent-a-painting plan" designed to enable a person who wishes to live with a painting for a while before buying it to hang it in his own home, apartment or place of business at a monthly charge.
