SET UP in a trailer, the credit office will allow shoppers to open charge accounts at more than one store in the city, thus eliminating the need to fill out credit forms at each store where they want to open accounts.

The trailer will have a direct telephone line to the Birmingham Credit Bureau, where an applicant's credit will be immediately established while the customer waits.

The credit center is believed to be the first of its kind in the nation.

ALSO IN the trailer will be a special information service provided by the chamber. Shoppers will be able to get information on where to buy any specific item they might want.

"Ask Miss Powell" (as the service is called) girls will attempt to find out whether a specific kind of merchandise is available in Birmingham. If a particular item is available in more than one store, a list of all of the stores will be supplied to the shopper.

A third service to be housed in the trailer will be a fancy gift-wrapping service under the direction of LaBelle's.
