The Dec. 18 meeting, whose guests of honor include members' youngsters, will be held at the Oakland Branch of the YWCA.



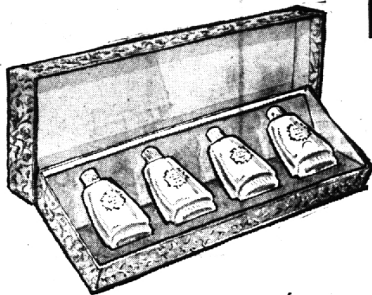
