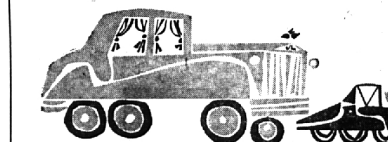

1st Helicopter Solo a Success

Naval Aviation Cadet William C. Bollinger, son of Mr. and Mrs. Jesse W. Bollinger of 1536 Kirkway Drive, Bloomfield Hills, completed his first helicopter solo flight recently while with Helicopter Training Squadron Eight at the Ellison Air Landing Field, Pensacola, Fla.

In preparation for qualification as a helicopter pilot he completed an extensive ground training course in rotary wing aircraft principles and will receive flight instruction in the Navy's Bell and Sikorsky helicopter.

Upon completion of his helicopter training Bollinger will be designated a naval aviator and commissioned Ensign in the Naval Reserve. Before entering the Navy in May 1962, Bollinger attended Western Michigan University, Kalamazoo, Mich.
