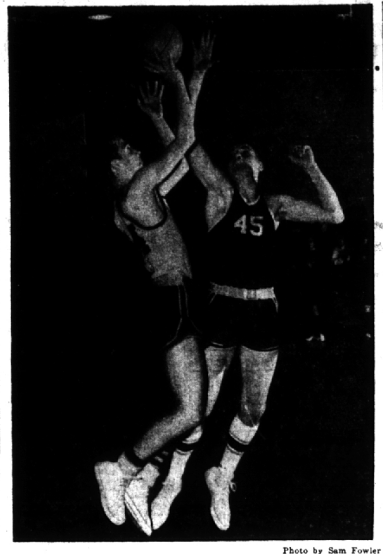

Country Day Loses Twice On Harcourt

Country Day's basketball team, much improved over a year ago, ran into shooting trouble and dropped two ball games within a week. The Yellowjackets lost to Whitmore Lake on Friday, 51-45, after trailing 21-0 in the first quarter. Paul Sonda led the team with 21 points and 14 rebounds. Monday night, Goodrich dumped Country Day, 55-32, as the Day School hit on only 3 of 36 shots in the second half. Mike Dunn got 20 of the 32 points, and all three shots from the floor in the second half.

COUNTRY DAY is now 1-3 on the year and doesn't play again until Jan. 10 against Maumee. The JV squad beat Goodrich as Bob Davenport poured in 21 points. Country Day went 1-1 in wrestling over the weekend. Cranbrook's reserves edged the Yellowjackets, 40-38, but Country Day overwhelmed Clinton, 55-5.

Tom Gorsich, Bob Backstrom, Jamie Sonda, Brian Swain, Charles Pullum, John Swain, Al Saylor, Rick Olson and Lee DeGarin all won on pins.
