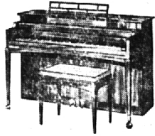


Birth Announced

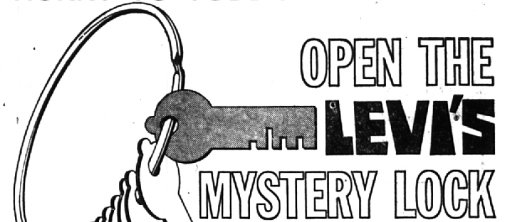
