Name's Not the Same Is University's Claim

Tired of its cumbersome name, which had also led to confusion of the institution's status, Michigan State University - Oakland has streamlined down to Oakland University.

The name almost remained the same when university officials could not agree on a suitable name change last month and decided to leave it MSUO.

But last weekend the Board of Trustees took the plunge and on Monday they made a public announcement of the new Oakland University designation.

ACCORDING TO Oakland Chancellor D. B. Varner, the old name seemed to indicate to many people that the university was merely a "branch" or "extension" of Michigan State University.

Numerous young people, it was reported, thought MSUO was a school for Michigan State students who failed to keep their grades up at MSU proper.

As Oakland University, the 1,150-student, four-year institution achieves "sister status" with Mich-

igan State University in East Lansing.

The newly named university will continue its affiliation with MSU under the same president and board of trustees.

Otherwise Oakland U. is strictly on its own.

THE BOARD OF Trustees did not reveal the name change until Monday because they first wanted to contact Mrs. Alfred G. Wilson, the school's original donor, over the weekend and tell her the news. Mrs. Wilson lives in Scottsdale, Ariz.

Oakland students, including a prospective first graduating class of between 140-150 collegians in April, were also given an advance notice of the new name.

Chrysler Suit Against Former Resident Dropped

A suit against former Birmingham resident and Chrysler Corp. official Jack W. Minor has been dismissed in Oakland County Circuit Court following an out-of-court settlement.

Attorneys for Minor and Chrysler did not reveal the details of the settlement.

A statement issued by Chrysler said simply that both parties were satisfied with the settlement.

IN THE SUIT Chrysler sought \$80,000 for recovery of profits Minor allegedly made through his connections with outside advertising and sales concerns while he was employed by the auto firm.

Minor had also filed suits in Wayne County Circuit Court for damages to his reputation and job chance and for his share of the firm's stock ownership program.
