Petitions Circulating Opposing Airport

Citizens of Oakland County opposed to the proposed expansion of the Allen Airport by the county are currently circulating petitions in this area in hopes of gaining 5,000 signatures by Tuesday.

The petitions will be sent to the Michigan State Board of Aeronautics and the chief of the airspace branch of the air traffic division of the Federal Aviation Agency.

Directing the signature-gathering is Mrs. Charles Naastrom of Pontiac. She estimates that about 1,500 people, primarily in the Lake Orion area, have already signed the petitions.

"THE ACTION is the result of the Pontiac city commission's resolution of Feb. 12 against the airport," she said.

Aiding her in circulating the petitions are members of the Oakland County Homeowners and Taxpayers Association. They are acting as individuals, not as an organization, she said.

Other interested persons are also helping, she said.
