Briggs Chairs GOP Board For 'Insight'

Insight, the quarterly publication put out by the Republican Party of Oakland County, now has a Board of Directors chaired by W. O. Briggs III.
Charles L. Lyle, GOP county chairman, made the announcement this week. Lyle said that Insight has been in existence for two years but that it had been the total responsibility of the Public Relations Committee working with the Education Committee in the past.
"Insight has grown to such proportions that it was felt that it should have its own Board of Directors," Lyle said.

Ray Hallard of Huntington Woods, rules and resolutions; Walter O. Koch of Royal Oak and Philip Baden of Pleasant Ridge, campaign organization; William Miller, Farmington and Robert E. Schwab, 3080 Oakhill, Birmingham, club organization; and Rodkey Craighead, 245 Harrow Circle, Birmingham, finance.

Briggs said that the board will hold their first meeting on February 28 at Headquarters to decide on the March issue of Insight.

DeCOOKE, 35, of 29195 Spring Road, has lived here for four years and is a civil engineer with the U.S. Lake Survey. He holds a BS degree in civil engineering and has one daughter. He is a past president of the Wood Creek Farms Civic Association and was its secretary for two years.
He says, "I feel that I am qualified for the position of village councilman since during the four years I have resided here, I have taken an active part in its social and civic functions and have kept abreast of current local problems and those which will be confronting the village in the very near future."

level where educational plans and relationships are likely to be most highly crystallized.
"The decision should reflect our desire and determination to place the highest priority on those factors which must directly affect the educational welfare of our children and youth."
