Home of Methodism

Methodism in Birmingham dates back to 1821 when a traveling itinerant preached the first sermon in Willett's Log Tavern. Today's First Methodist Church of Birmingham, pictured in this aerial photograph by Sid Cole for the Eccentric's church, held its ground breaking in 1950 for a \$640,000 church on a five-acre site at the corner of Pleasant and E. Maple. Additional facilities in 1954 and

1957 brought the church property up to 8.65 acres. Other homes occupied by the Methodist congregation have included the first church building in Birmingham, a frame structure erected in 1839 at the corner of Merrill and Bates Sts. In 1871 members helped to build a new \$20,000 church home, with men hauling materials and women cooking meals, at Maple and Henrietta where Kresge's now stands.

Plans for issuing \$40,000 more of the scrip were tentatively approved at a meeting in the Community House.

Tuguey, 612 E. Maple, who last December petitioned for the closing of this 160-foot leftover from the opening of Hunter boulevard.

Recognizing the desires of a large number of residents in the Eton road-Maple avenue area, the city commission Monday evening turned down a petition for the rezoning of two and a half blocks from single terrace classification. Property owners were emphatic in their requests to have the commissioners deny the petition, claiming that the proposed terraces would devalue their single residence properties.
