Bridge Player To Sponsor Tournament

E. V. Clarke, 792 Willets, Birmingham, of the Southern Michigan Bridge Association, is the sponsor of an area tournament to benefit the Institute of Logopedics in Wichita, Kansas.

Members of the American Contract Bridge League are making a nationwide effort to help raise funds for the communicatively handicapped at the institute which is the world's largest residential habilitation center serving speech and hearing handicapped.

The bridge league will hold a National Championship Game at Minneapolis, Minn., July 28.

THIS YEAR for the first time, hundreds of ACBL affiliates, including the ones in Birmingham, will begin to play exactly the same bridge hands at 8:30 p.m.

The Institute of Logopedics is the bridge league's co-charity for 1962-63, together with the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, and will receive proceeds from a series of duplicate bridge tournaments sponsored by affiliates throughout the year.

Naturalist Leaves To Band Birds In Central America

Walter Nickell, associate naturalist at Cranbrook Institute of Science, has left on his fourth consecutive bird banding trip to British Honduras.

He will set up his mist nets on the outskirts of Stann Creek and will conduct research trips from there to establish migratory data.

Nickell said there are three major purposes of his trip, namely to establish data on the banded birds that return to exact winter quarters, to establish migratory routes along the Caribbean and to band birds to be recovered during the next nesting season in the United States.
