Offer Courses In Flying at Clawson High

Two 10-week courses in flying will be offered by the Clawson Public Schools adult education department.

The first, "Aviation Fundamentals I," will begin on Wednesday, March 27, in Room 107 of the high school, 101 John M., from 7 to 9 p.m. each Tuesday.

The course deals with further aspects of aircraft, navigation, meteorology and federal aviation regulations. In addition, typical written examinations for the private pilot rating will be reviewed in detail. Previous aviation experience or completion of Aviation Fundamentals I is recommended.

THE OTHER course, "Aviation Instrument Rating," will be offered starting March 28. It will provide sufficient background to successfully complete the oral and written requirements for the instrument rating.

It consists of a review of fundamentals, plus advanced study in navigation, radio, meteorology, federal air regulations, computer and use of charts.

Those interested in taking the courses should register before the office of George A. Grice, assistant superintendent of Clawson Public Schools between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Collects Bounty
In Michigan for
Wisconsin Coyote

Fraudulent practices are sometimes hard to spot under the bounty system, but conservation officers from Wisconsin and Michigan teamed up recently to uncover one such case involving an Upper Peninsula resident.

The man, Anthony J. Petroff, Capitan, was arrested and fined last month for trying to collect a \$15 bounty at Crystal Falls for a male coyote he had taken from Wisconsin.

THE CASE started when a Wisconsin trapper complained to officers that someone had killed a coyote in one of his traps and had taken both trap and coyote. Petroff reportedly had been hunting in the area that day, and Wisconsin officers alerted Michigan officers of the offense.

After Petroff applied for the bounty payment at Crystal Falls, he was questioned and admitted his guilt.
