

Marian Instructor Wins Fullbright Grant

Sister M. Xaveria, of the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Monroe, Mich., currently teaching at Marian High School, Birmingham, recently learned that she had won a Fulbright Grant to India. The grant will take Sister Xaveria to the University of Mysore in Mysore, India, for the Summer Institute in Indian Civilization.

The Sister gained her experience in teaching at both the Detroit and Monroe campuses of Marygrove College, and in secondary schools in Akron, Ohio, Mt. Clemens and Flint.

SISTER XAVERIA, author of "Europe and the Mediterranean" (Doubleday), and co-author of "Lands of the Eastern Hemisphere" (Doubleday), received her Ph.D. from the University of Michigan. She has also written a number of periodical articles and is co-author of the "Everett Curriculum Report" of the Sister Formation. She has been an active member of the Sister Formation for a number of years, which has included a study of teacher training under a grant from the Ford Foundation for the advancement of education.

The Sister's other activities include membership in Phi Beta Kappa, Phi Kappa Phi and Sigma Xi. Sister Xaveria will leave for India on June 11, after a three-day orientation program for Fulbright winners in Washington.

Fellowship Awarded For Postdoctoral Physics Research

The National Academy of Sciences-National Research Council announces that George Zweig of Birmingham has been awarded an NAS-NRC postdoctoral research fellowship.

Zweig expects to receive his Ph.D. in theoretical physics from California Institute of Technology in June of this year.

He will continue research in theoretical and experimental elementary particle physics at CERN (European Organization for Nuclear Research, in Geneva, Switzerland, under the direction of Dr. V. F. Weisskopf.

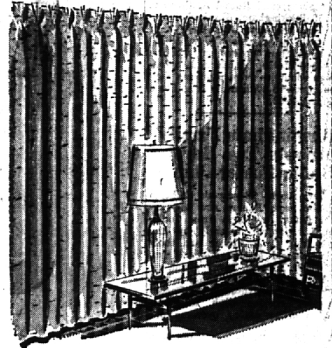
