Michigan Week Awards To Be Given in County

Oakland County's three winners in the 10th annual Michigan Week product and achievement contest will receive their county awards at a luncheon meeting at Devon Gables, Telegraph and Long Lake Roads, Bloomfield Hills, at noon Friday.

Announcement of the meeting and of the winners was made by W. L. Whitfield, Oakland County awards chairman and division manager of Consumers Power Co.

Winners claiming the honor of representing Oakland County in the state-wide competition are:

Community Achievement of the Year — The Community of South Lyon for a campaign for a public library carried to success under leadership of the Junior Chamber of Commerce and supported by civic, service and other groups.

Agricultural Process of the Year — Erwin Orchards of South Lyon for a controlled atmosphere process of storing apples.

Product of the Year — Pontiac Motor Co. of Pontiac for the Grand Prix automobile.

PRESENTATION of the county awards will be made by Whitfield following a discussion of the activities planned for Michigan Week May 19-25 by Robert J. Huber, Oakland County Michigan Week chairman and president of Michigan Chrome and Chemical Co.

From Oakland County the winning entries will be forwarded to regional eliminations which will be held by state-wide judging and announcement of state winners during Michigan Week.

Judges of the Oakland County contest were, Community Achievement — Paul N. Averill, publisher of The Birmingham Eccentric, and James C. Covert, director of community relations for William Beaumont Hospital; Agricultural Process — Lyle B. Abel, director of the Oakland County Cooperative Extension Service; Product — Grant W. Howell, managing editor of The Daily Tribune, Royal Oak; Montgomery Ferrar of Sundberg-Ferrar, designers; and Leslie M. Gilliland, general manager of the Montgomery-Ward store at Pontiac Mall.

Among guests invited to the award luncheon, in addition to representatives of the sponsoring organizations and the judges, are Mayor Robert A. Landry of Pontiac; James W. Huttenlocher and Richard Pflager, Pontiac community co-chairmen for Michigan Week; Mayor John E. Noel of South Lyon, and Dr. Ronald W. Evasio, South Lyon Michigan Week community chairman.
