AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 67 KNOWN AS THE ZONING ORDINANCE

The Township of Bloomfield Ordains:

Section I.01. That Ordinance No. 67 known as the Zoning Ordinance be and the same hereby is amended by amending the Zoning Map included therein and made a part thereof as follows:

- A. That the following described property is changed from R-M Multiple Family Residential District use to 0-1 Office Building District use;
