Ford Motor Gives Award To Employee

Bernard C. Schmidt, 4315 Orchard Hill Drive, Birmingham, was among eight Ford Motor employees cited for outstanding community service at the fourth annual Macomb County Community Service Awards program Tuesday at Ford's Sterling Plant.

SCHMIDT is suggestion program coordinator for the Sterling Plant. He was awarded a plaque bearing an engraved commendation from Henry Ford II, chairman of the board of Ford Motor Co.

Schmidt is president of the Friends and Relatives of Mentally Retarded Children of South Oakland County, an organization that provides two centers of education and training for more than 70 retarded children.

Three requests for zoning alterations in Birmingham were referred to the plan board by city commissioners Monday night.

Arnold Becker has petitioned to change the present zoning classification from R-1 (single family) to R-5 (multiple family) on five lots on the east side of Southfield between Lincoln and Northlawn.

Becker proposes to build apartment units of a colonial design on the sites. He said they would be landscaped and properly screened from adjoining properties.

At the present time there is no alley or right of way to either Pierce or Henrietta streets.

A REQUEST by Anthony Durillo and Gayle E. Carter to rezone property they own along the alley on the west side of Woodward near Emmott from residential classification to parking was also turned over to the plan board.

City commissioners first thought the request would fall under the blanket approval by the plan board for such changes in that area. They decided to pass the request along because all of the property lies adjacent to the alley.

BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP—A mile of Quanton Road, from Inkster to Franklin roads, will be improved over the next two years by the township in conjunction with the Oakland County Road Commission. Cost of the improvement, estimated at \$87,500, will be shared jointly.
