## Detroit Boy Receives Scholarship

Named winner of a \$1500 scholarship for next year to the Cranbrook School for Boys was Eddie James Randle, 14, and "All-A" eighth grader at Douglass Houghton School. He is the eldest son in a Detroit family which is presently receiving funds through Aid to Dependent Children.

Eddie hopes he will be able to take advantage of the scholarship. However, another \$1000 is needed to cover the \$2500 tuition fee, plus incidental expenses such as books.

He and 14 other boys were selected from more than 40 applicants. About 11 per cent of Cranbrook students are scholarship holders. He and another boy, C. Walter Valentine of Columbus, O., are the first two Negroes to be awarded Scholarships by the school.

ple-family based on rooms  
2-or-less-room unit—1.50 spaces per unit

The requirements will be discussed at a public hearing before the city commission Monday night.

ALTHOUGH they made no definite recommendations on the commercial parking requirements, the planners agreed that "revisions are in order."

Each board member was asked to submit what he thought should be the commercial parking requirements based on the nature of the business to City Planner William R. Brownfield.

Brownfield will compile an average from the recommendations and submit them to the city commission for study.  
IN A discussion on the use of R-7 zoned property in the southwest quadrant of the downtown area, the board generally agreed they were against the permitting of nonretail property under the present zoning ordinance.  
Brownfield said, however, if the zoning ordinance were ever changed the mixing of the two classifications might be desirable to the board in some instances.

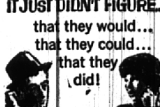

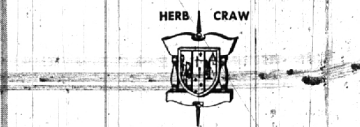
