The National Merit Scholarship Corp. annually conducts a competition in which 600,000 high school juniors participate. From about 175 of these—one in every eight—indicate they will attend MSU.

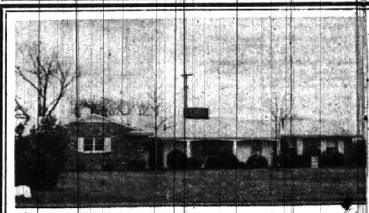

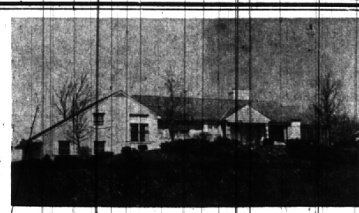
### Local Writer's Play Televised Sunday
