 THE ARCHITECTURAL firm had its beginning in Detroit in 1908. Its operations today have included projects throughout the United States and in Canada, Mexico, Latin America and Europe. The State Department's new office building in Washington, D.C., considered one of the largest in the world, was designed by Harley, Ellington, Cowin and Burton, Inc. Current projects in the Metropolitan Detroit area include the Fries Auditorium at the Grosvenor Pointe War Memorial, the Macca-bies building in Southfield, the new 24-story Detroit Bank and Trust Co. building in downtown Detroit, the Dearborn Civic Center, the Louth Steel Co. office building, the Bendis Corp. Systems Division Staff Building.

Motor Fund Pays County For Quarter

Oakland County will be paid \$1,536,359 from first quarter Motor Vehicle Highway Fund collections being distributed by the State Highway Department at Lansing. Amounts to be paid incorporated cities and villages include Birmingham Farms, \$2,031; Birmingham, \$88,174; Bloomfield Hills, \$11,271; Latrup Village, \$12,687; and Southfield, \$148,742.

STATE HIGHWAY Commissioner John C. Mackie said net receipts of the Highway Fund during January, February and March of 1963 amounted to \$87,311,745. This is an increase of \$5,580,076 compared to the same period of 1962.

Local Youths Attend Wolverine Boys State

Local service organizations will send a record 21 high school Juniors to the twenty-sixth annual Wolverine Boys' State. The seven day program will run from June 15 to June 20, with an estimated attendance of 1,150. Sponsored by the American Legion, the camp is held on the Michigan State University campus in East Lansing.

Representing the Birmingham area, Groves' Seaholm, Rice and Troy high school students will have a chance to participate in the simulated workings of all phases of government. Arriving in Lansing, the boys are divided into two equal political parties and assigned to their living quarters, where each group of twenty boys is designated a "city". Two cities make up a "county". Immediately, campaigning begins for the hundreds of city, county, and state elective offices. All the regular political procedures are followed, from the election of a governing executive to the holding of the state elections. By the end of the third day at Boys' State every boy has some office, whether it be County State Chairman, or a member of the state legislature.

Next the mock government is put into operation, and trials, Senate and House meetings, and a committee of the state government, the boys' actual experience in the workings of government. A Boy's State band and glee club is organized, a daily paper is published, and there is athletic competition carried on between cities. At the end of the week the two outstanding members of Boys' State are nominated for the national camp which is conducted with our national government.
