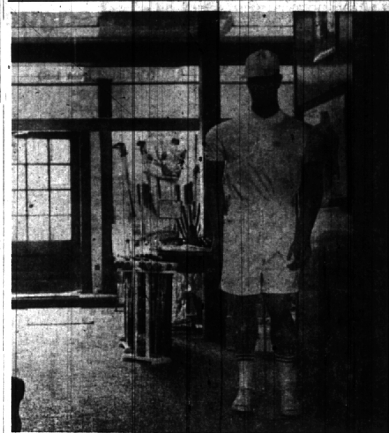
**Movie Wins Award**
