

County Won't Meet Expected Deficit In Clinics' Budget

The Oakland County Child Guidance Clinics' expected deficit of \$6,500 by year-end will not be met by Oakland County, according to David Levinson, chairman of the county Board of Supervisor Ways and Means Committee.

County auditors have reported that the clinics probably will exceed their budget by the \$6,500 figure, and the county has been asked to make up the difference. The Ways and Means Committee is largely responsible for determining county expenditures, in providing additional financial aid to the clinics, Levinson pointed out that the county is only one of several revenue sources of the clinic.

The committee that the county pay for its share of increased Blue Cross-Blue Shield hospital insurance rates for county employees.

On a continued basis of paying 50 per cent of insurance costs, the increased rates will cost the county \$16,000 this year and \$21,000 next year.

Oakland County Registers 50,770 New Cars in '62

A Michigan Department of State survey shows that 50,770 new cars and 3,293 new trucks were registered in Oakland County last year. According to Secretary of State James M. Hare, 453,064 new passenger automobiles and 49,256 new trucks were registered during the same one-year period by the department's 250 branch offices which serve Michigan's 83 counties. The total number of old and new motor vehicles in Michigan at the beginning of the year was 3,869,238.

THE COMMITTEE, however, has approved an additional expenditure of \$3,000 by the juvenile division of Probate Court to expand its on-the-job training for court wards.

"THROUGHOUT the nation, new passenger car registrations dropped during 1961 by nearly three-fourths of a million units," Hare said. "Then in 1962, national registrations of new automobiles zoomed to an all-time high of 6,338,863. The total number of old and new motor vehicles in the United States is now estimated to be 78,631,000."

In 1962, the state collected \$68,515,538.53 in motor vehicle taxes. Passenger cars accounted for \$30,397,544.21; commercial cars for \$21,267,096.52; trailers for \$9,341,007.78; farm tractors for \$1,032,370.78; house trailers for \$245,932.47; motorcycles for \$109,264.21; and municipally owned vehicles for \$21,142.55.

Jenkins not only provided the tickets for Judy and her parents through Birmingham's Bee Kalt Travel Service, but the travel agency arranged for special attention to the ailing child at the airport Monday morning.

The parents, Mr. and Mrs. James Mushenski accepted only one-way tickets from Jenkins, saying his offer for round trip was "too much". Neighbors of their Colesburg, Ia. home have provided \$183 toward Judy's hospital expenses.

Jenkins is connected with Jenkins Investment Co., and developer of Birmingham's Jenkins Building.

Police Chief Lists Rate of Accidents

Failure to yield right of way ranks as the most dangerous driver violation as far as accidents are concerned, according to Ralph W. Moxley, Birmingham Chief of Police.

This violation was present in 22 of the 62 accidents investigated by Birmingham police in April.

STOP SIGN violations, traffic signal violations, failure to use caution at open intersections and pulling into moving traffic from private drives and alleys contributed to the violation.

Birmingham police issued 400 tickets to drivers for stop sign and traffic signal violations during the first four months of 1962.

The April accident summary included 4 property damage accidents and 28 persons injured.
