

4 Area Boys Leave For Trip to Alaska

Bound for Alaska on the seventh annual trip for boys, conducted by Edward J. Kuhn of Pontiac, are four Birmingham and Bloomfield Hills youngsters.

Circuit Judge To Hold Court In Auditorium

The newly completed new supervisors' auditorium in the courthouse has been recommended as a courtroom for the seventh Oakland County circuit judge, to be appointed by Gov. Romney Sept. 6.

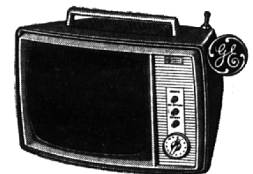
