

Highway Dept. Expands Freeway to Six Lanes

LANSING—State Highway Commissioner John C. Mackie has announced that 77 miles of interstate freeway in Michigan will be expanded from four to six lanes in 1967.

Mackie said the projects, which will cost an estimated \$24 million, will be necessary to meet anticipated traffic volumes in the mid-1970's.

All of the projects will be financed with 90 per cent federal funds and 10 per cent state funds. Sections of freeway to be expanded include:

—23 miles of I-96 from the north west edge of Detroit to Brighton. Estimated cost, \$5.3 million. To be done in 1966.

—33.3 miles of I-94 from the junction of I-96 (now under construction) near Benton Harbor south to New Buffalo. Estimated cost \$8 million. To be done in 1966.

—5.4 MILES of I-94 from US-23 freeway south of Ann Arbor east to US-12 southeast of Ypsilanti. Estimated cost, \$6 million. To be done in 1967.

Mackie said I-96 between Detroit and Brighton was originally built with only four lanes because the Highway Department didn't have enough funds along with other commitments to build it as a six-lane freeway.

Construction on this section of I-96—the oldest section of the 170-mile Detroit-Muskegon Freeway—was started in 1955. It was built with 60 per cent federal funds and 40 per cent state funds in 1956 and 1957.

ABOUT A year after construction started, Congress approved the Federal Highway Act of 1956 which provided for 90 per cent federal financing on all interstate freeway projects.

Mackie said the big interchange at Brighton linking I-96 and the Ohio-Mackinac Bridge Freeway (US-23) was built to accommodate six lanes of traffic and that no additional work will be required on the interchange.

All of I-94 between Willow Run Airport and Telegraph Road was built during World War II as part of the Detroit Industrial Expressway and later became part of I-94.

The section of I-94 between Benton Harbor and New Buffalo in Berrien County was opened between 1960 and 1962.

IT WAS BUILT as a four-lane divided freeway in order to conserve funds at that time, and it was decided to expand it to six lanes when funds became available.

Traffic volumes on this section of I-94 are expected to increase steadily when I-96 is completed. Traffic between Hartwood and Highland last this year and next year.
