AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 29 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE INC.
ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE RECULATING AND
RESTRICTING THE HEIGHT, NUMBER OF STORIES
AND SIZE OF BUILDINGS: THE SIZE OF OPEN
SPACES: THE DENSITY OF POPULATION: THE LO-CATION AND USE OF BUILDINGS AND LAND FOR TRADE, RESIDENCE AND OTHER PURPOSES: CREATING DISTRICTS FOR SAID PURPOSES AND CREATING DISTRICTS FOR SAID FURTUSES AND ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR CHANGES IN REGULATIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND BOUNDARIES OF SUCH DISTRICTS: DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS USED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT: ESTABLISH-MENT OF A ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS: AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE."

The Village of Beverly Hills Ordains:

Section 1.01. That Ordinance No. 29, being the Zoning Ordinance, be and the same hereby is amended by amend-ing the Zoning Map attached thereto and made a part thereof as follows:

That the following described property is changed from a single family residential 2 zone use to Parking (P) zone use. to wit:

Lots 56 to 60, both inclusive, of D. J. Healy's Golfhurst Subdivision, Village of Beverly Hills, Oakland County, Michigan.

Section 2.01. Public hearing having been held hereon on July 15, 1963, and the statutory notices having been published and mailed, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be immediately necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety and are hereby ordered to take effect immediately upon publica-
