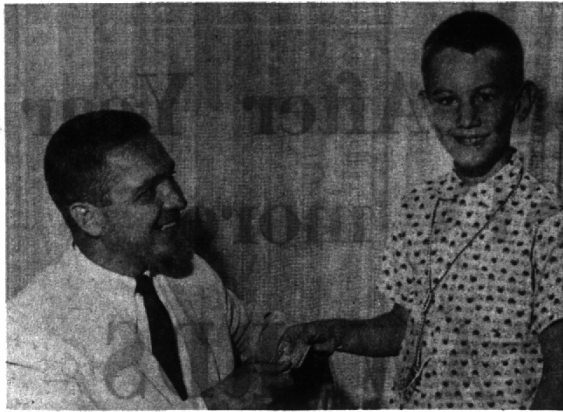


Railroad Strike Won't Halt Most Express Service

Should negotiators fail to reach a settlement in the nationwide rail dispute, bringing on a strike, the following changes in service will be instituted by REA Express, according to G. C. Luce, REA vice president.

"If the railroad strike cannot be avoided by July 29, REA Express may have some limited areas under embargo; but by and large we will continue to operate between all principal offices and, with some few exceptions, by means of our own over the main road services and other available means."

REA AIR EXPRESS, he said, "will continue on a non-mail basis to all principal points with its priority next to that of regular air mail." Details of the emergency service plan will be made as soon as it is possible or necessary. The Birmingham area is serviced by the Royal Oak office of REA.
